DAILY ITINERARY

Day 1 *Depart for Alaska.* Our flight from Minneapolis is bound for Fairbanks where the 4th of July celebration lights the night time sky—it's called the MIDNIGHT SUN! Overnight hotel in Fairbanks for three nights.

Day 2 *Fairbanks.* Morning at leisure. Our afternoon in Alaska's "Golden Heart City" includes a visit to El Dorado Gold Camp, a working gold mine operation where you can pan for gold. You'll also see the Trans-Alaska Pipeline.

Day 3 *Fairbanks.* Today we'll have either a morning or afternoon cruise aboard the sternwheeler RIVERBOAT DISCOVERY with more time to explore Fairbanks and the many activities it has to offer.

Day 4 *Fairbanks/Denali.* Board the Midnight Sun Express and settle into your plushy-upholstered chair in the dome lounge. You may purchase coffee or cocktails from the on-board staff, as your guide points out sights along the way. Upon arrival transfer to the charming Denali Princess Lodge. Afternoon will be free for optional rafting, helicopter rides or relaxing in the heated Jacuzzi.

Day 5 *Denali/McKinley.* Join us for a fascinating Natural History Tour into Denali National Park. After the tour, depart via motorcoach to Mt. McKinley Wilderness Lodge. Evening at leisure.

Day 6 *McKinley/Anchorage.* Morning at leisure for hiking or relaxing at this wonderful lodge. Afternoon via motorcoach to the quaint town of Talkeetna to board the Midnight Sun Express bound for Anchorage.

Day 7 *Anchorage Tour/Whittier.* We'll get a quick look at Anchorage before heading south towards Whittier by motorcoach. We'll travel along the shoreline between the Chugach Mountains and the waters of the Turnagain Arm to Whittier where you will board the DIAMOND PRINCESS scheduled to sail at 8:30 pm. **L,D**

Day 8 *Cruising to Hubbard Glacier.* Scenic cruising including the Hubbard Glacier. You'll see the legendary "blue ice" and may experience the thunderous roar of an iceberg "calving" as you stand in awe before majestic mountains and fjords created by these massive rivers of ice. It's a sight, sound and feeling you'll never forget. **B,L,D**

Day 9 *Cruising Glacier Bay.* Massive glaciers stretch from the ice-draped St. Elias and Fairweather mountain ranges to sit at the end of majestic fjords. The Muir, John Hopkins and Margerie Glaciers are the most active. A Glacier Bay Ranger Naturalist will be on board to make your experience complete. **B,L,D**



Day 10 *Skagway.* A full day to explore this gateway to the gold fields and memories of the Gold Rush of '98. Step back into history at the Trail of '98 Museum, sightsee along the White Pass rail route to the Yukon, or try sportfishing, mountain biking or flightseeing. **B,L,D**

Day 11 *Juneau.* This is the State Capital and the only one in the U.S. that you cannot drive to. A fascinating place to explore. Sightsee and shop in town, or choose from a wide array of optional shore excursions. **B,L,D**

Day 12 *Ketchikan.* Southeast Alaska's "First City", Ketchikan is as picturesque as they come. The town is built on piles out over the water and clings to the slopes of Deer Mountain. Native cultures abound at Saxman Village and Totem Bight State Park. **B,L,D**

Day 13 *Inside Passage Cruising.* When you rise this morning check your copy of the ship's newsletter for a full list of the activities that are offered. **B,L,D**

Day 14 *Vancouver.* We arrive in Canada's main west coast seaport this morning. After clearing customs we transfer to Vancouver airport for our return flight to Minneapolis. **B**
