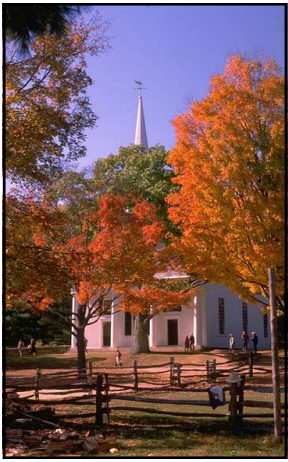

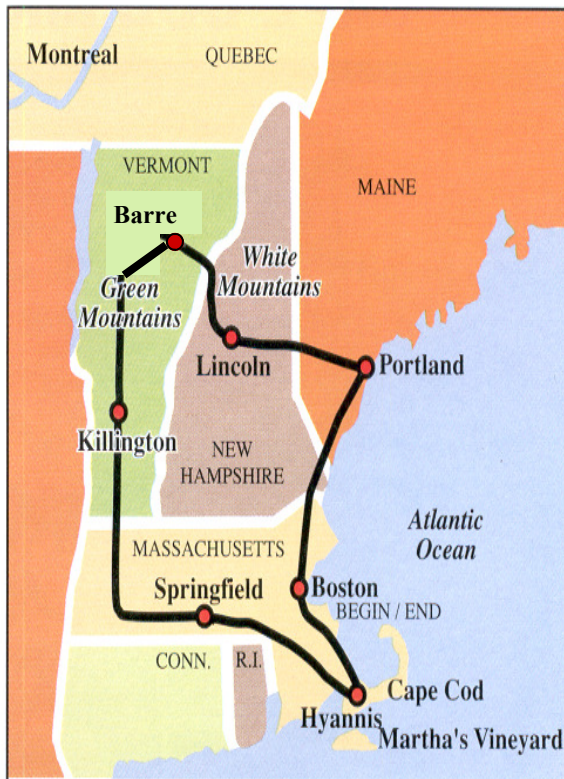

This evening we relax at our pre-tour hotel in Minneapolis, prior to our early morning flight departure to Boston.

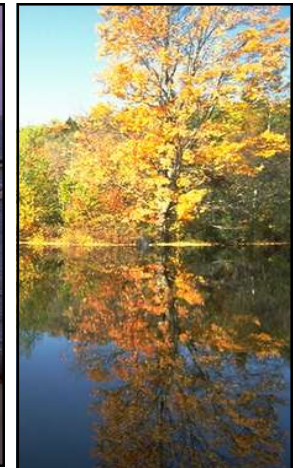

DAY 2 (CB,D)

MINNEAPOLIS TO BOSTON

Welcome to New England! Upon arrival in **Boston**, we'll spend the afternoon touring Boston's historic highlights. This city is a blend of historic buildings and contemporary skyscrapers. Enjoy time for lunch on our own at famous **Quincy Market**. Visit many of the famous sites along the **Freedom Trail**, including the **USS Constitution** (Old Ironsides), the **Old North Church** and **Faneuil Hall**. We will travel past the Old State House, Kings Chapel, the Old Granary Burial Ground and Beacon Hill as our local guide relates the history, folklore and current events of Boston. A welcome dinner is included.

DAY 3 SALEM—KENNEBUNKPORT—PORTLAND

(B) After breakfast at the hotel, travel to historic Salem and tour the **House of the Seven Gables** and the birthplace of Nathaniel Hawthorne, author of the *Scarlet Letter*. We'll travel through the New Hampshire seacoast region to Ogunquit, Maine. Here we'll board a special **lobster tour boat** to learn how the Maine lobstermen make their living. This trip combines the scenic beauty of Ogunquit's shoreline with first-hand lobstering. Next, visit the coastal village of **Kennebunkport**. Enjoy time to browse the many quaint shops of this village before taking a drive out to Walker's Point and past the summer home of former President George H.W. Bush. This evening we arrive in Portland, Maine with time for dinner on our own at the hotel or one of the many restaurants in the area. *Fireside Inn & Suites, Portland, ME*

DAY 4 PORTLAND—NORTH CONWAY—LINCOLN

(B,D) After a buffet breakfast, we'll meet our local guide for a tour of Portland, Maine's largest city by the sea. Visit the most photographed lighthouse in the world, **Portland Head Lighthouse**. Travel past Longfellow's boyhood home, sea captain's homes, the elegant Victoria Mansion and the islands of Casco Bay in Portland Harbor. Next, we travel inland to **North Conway Village**, New Hampshire. Enjoy lunch on our own and time to browse the many shops of the village. Travel the **Kancamagus Scenic Byway** through the White Mountains of New Hampshire. Take in the spectacular fall foliage as we tour through Franconia Notch State Park. This afternoon experience the **Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway**, one of New England's most spectacular rides which brings us to the summit of Cannon Mountain. On a clear day you can enjoy views of New Hampshire, Maine, Vermont, Canada and New York! Dinner is included this evening.

DAY 5 BARRE—MONTPELIER—KILLINGTON / RUTLAND

(B) This morning enjoy the colorful countryside of New Hampshire and Vermont as we make our way to Rock of Ages and see the world's largest deep-hole, dimension granite quarry—a quarry nearly 600 feet deep! We will enjoy an included lunch at the Lodge at Millstone Hill and then continue on to Hope Cemetery where every single stone is made out of "Barre Grey" granite. Our next stop will be at Morse Farm Sugar Works, just outside of Montpelier, VT. Take a glimpse into the history of early farm life in Vermont and enjoy "sugar on snow", a delicious maple syrup treat. Enjoy time to shop the gift shop, featuring all maple products and Vermont specialty foods. Relax and enjoy the scenic drive through the picturesque hillsides of Vermont as we make our way to Killington/Rutland for our evening stay.

DAY 6

(B) After breakfast we'll travel to Manchester, Vermont. Tour the **Hildene Museum**, home of Robert Todd Lincoln, the eldest son of President Abraham and Mary Todd Lincoln. We will then cross into the **Berkshire Mountain region** of western Massachusetts and tour the restored **Hancock Shaker Village**. There are 21 historic buildings here, including the famous round stone barn, a working historical farm and gardens. Enjoy a hearty lunch on our own at the village before we travel to the classic New England village of Stockbridge and visit the **Norman Rockwell Art Museum**, featuring the largest permanent collection of Rockwell paintings and special exhibits. Late this afternoon we continue on to West Springfield for our evening stay and dinner on our own. *Hampton Inn, W. Springfield, MA*

DAY 7

SPRINGFIELD—CAPE COD

(B,L) This morning we visit the **Dr. Seuss Sculpture Garden** before traveling to the Sturbridge area for a **colonial lunch at the historic Salem Cross Inn**. The original building was constructed by a grandson of Peregrine White, the first male child born on the Mayflower in 1620. Experience their hospitality amid fieldstone fireplaces, chestnut ceiling beams and extensive antique furnishings. This afternoon, travel east to the seashore of **Cape Cod**. We'll meet a local guide for an afternoon **tour of Hyannis and Hyannisport**. Enjoy a picturesque stop at the **Kennedy and Korean War Memorials**. Travel past the church of the Kennedy family, St. Francis Xavier Church, before settling in to our hotel for the evening.

DAY 8

MARTHA'S VINEYARD

(B,D) After breakfast we head to Wood's Hole and enjoy a 90 minute **ferry crossing to the summer resort island of Martha's Vineyard**. Begin our tour in Oak Bluffs and stroll amidst the colorful Victorian gingerbread cottages. Enjoy time for lunch and shopping in Edgartown, once a whaling port. Later this afternoon we return to Hyannis to enjoy a farewell **traditional New England Lobster Dinner**.

DAY 9

CAPE COD—BOSTON—TWIN CITIES

(B) This morning we explore the historic sites between Cape Cod and Boston. First, stop in Plymouth for a tour of the **Mayflower II** replica ship. Enjoy time to shop for last minute gifts and souvenirs in this historic city. This afternoon we'll tour the **John F. Kennedy Library and Museum**, our nation's official memorial to the 35th president of the United States. We'll learn about the life and times of President Kennedy in an introductory film and visit 21 exhibits. One of the library's most popular ongoing exhibits is "Jacqueline Bouvier Kennedy: First Lady", which features items from her estate. Depart for Logan Airport this afternoon for our early evening flight home.
